“ In total, I remember seeing Uncle Ed a grand total of three times (the few days we sent with him and Auntie Lea counting as one), and I don't believe other members of my family spent more time than that with him. And both of them also welcomed us in their family with open arms.

And he always made it a point to share what he knows, what he learnt throughout his life, with us.

Finally, I think I speak for my whole family, those who knew him at least, when I say that, even though we were all hundreds or thousands of miles away from him, and we didn't talk that often, him and us, we always felt a comfort knowing he was there. And now that he isn't here we feel the emptiness of his absence, but we are also left with the joy we had – and still have – in knowing him, and the innumerable knowledge and wisdom he imparted on us.
