Albany-Albert J. Kelly, 92, died Sunday, July 13, 2014 at Schuyler Ridge Nursing Home. Born in Albany, he was the son of the late John and Frances Kelly. He was a World War II Marine Corps veteran. His battles and engagements included Roi-Namur, Saipan and Tinian.

After the war he married his wife Rose Marie in 1946. He worked for the IRS, US Post Office and City of Albany. His life of service included his devotion to Blessed Sacrament Church, where he was a member of the Holy Names Society and often volunteered his time in the Food Pantry Program.
