Albany – Retired Firefighter, Lt. Allan Stranahan, 72, of Albany, NY passed away on April 25, 2023, at the Community Hospice Inn at St. Peter’s Hospital. Allan was born in Albany to the late Dr. Allan Stranahan and Rachel Potter on August 2, 1950.

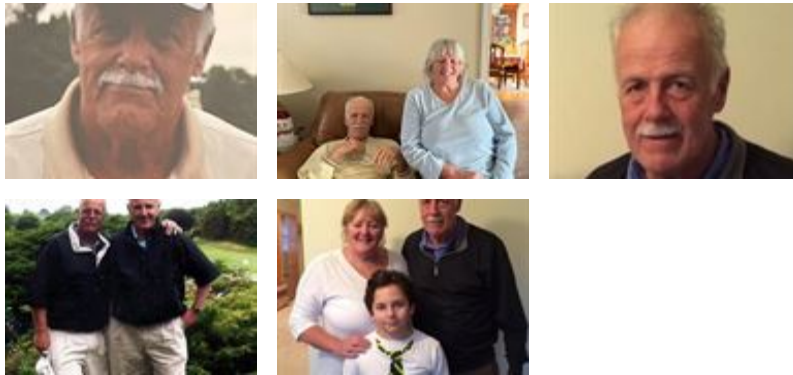
