Colonie, NY — Barbara Jean Pettit passed away March 28, 2025, peacefully at home. Born January 13, 1935, in Coxsackie, NY to Kenneth and Bertha Carter, Barbara graduated from Coxsackie-Athens High School in 1951 and St. Peter's School of Nursing in 1954. She married Peter E.
