Supercenter for over 20 years. She was a hardworking and dedicated worker, and her work ethic inspired all those around her.

Everyone that knew Bernadette knew she was a phenomenal cook. She loved going to the farmers market on the weekends and preparing farm-to-table meals. Her cooking was celebrated, the meals prepared for dinners and holidays brought people together. Bernadette also enjoyed spending time with her family through aforementioned dinners and holidays, as well as events such as birthdays and her grandchildren's sporting events. In her community, Bernadette was a Girl Scout leader, and an affiliate of Girl Scouts of the USA, as well as a softball coach.

She was selfless, resilient; there was nothing she could not do, and she persevered and survived so much that there was not a battle she could not fight. Bernadette was also a great listener and even better at giving advice. She was the most genuine and loving person to everyone that was important to her. She was easy to love and the glue that held everything together.
