August 28, 1932 - December 25, 2025

Albany, NY- Bridget Celine Coy (née Kenneally) of Albany, N.Y., age 93, passed away on December 25, 2025, at Albany Medical Center. Born in Newport, County Tipperary, Ireland, on August 28, 1932, she was the daughter of Thomas Kenneally and Mary McKeough Kenneally.

Bridie as she was known to many, came to the United States in the mid-1950s and initially worked at Albany Medical Center in the Records Department. She later worked at the New York Telephone Company. She was active in the Catholic Young Adult League in Albany, where she met and married Thomas (Tom) Coy. She continued to work at the New York Telephone until her oldest, T.K. was born. She then chose to forgo her career to focus on raising her three children.
