



Charles J. Smith

January 25, 1924 - April 13, 2015

Cohoes-Charles J. Smith, 91, died Monday, April 13, 2015 in the Hospice Inn at St. Peter's Hospital. Born in Colonie, he was the son of the late John and Julia McCann Smith.

Charles was a graduate of Albany High School. He was a US Army WW II veteran, serving from 1943 to 1944. Charles also served in the US Navy during the Korean War from 1949 to 1953.

He had worked at the Voorheesville Army Fire Department and later at the New York State Commerce Department. He was an Ambassador at the Albany International Airport, volunteer for the Red Cross and Meals on Wheels, and was a former member of the Elks. Charles enjoyed flying, golfing, fishing, and ballroom dancing.

He was the husband of the late Miriam Louise Porter Smith; beloved father of Charles J. Smith, Susan G. Smith (Robert Gronczniak) and the late Lois G. Smith-Law, who just passed away April 2, 2015; grandfather of Nicole D. Smith and Sean T. Smith; father-in-law of Chris Law; brother of the late John J. Smith, Robert V. Smith, Francis J. Smith and Donald J. Smith; survived by many nieces, nephews and friends.

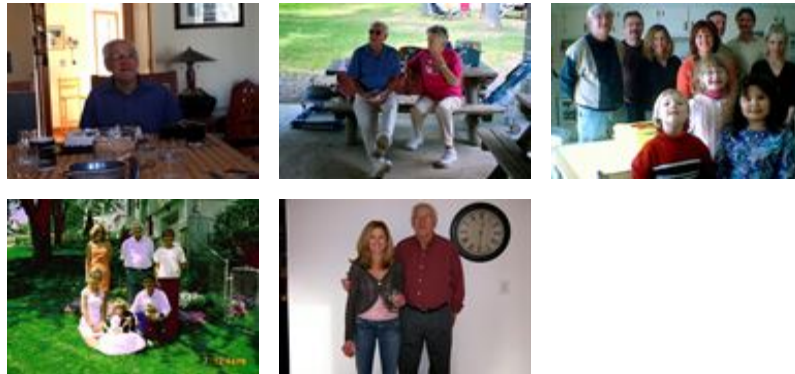
