August 7, 1947 - May 16, 2010

Ballston Lake-Daniel C. Day, 62, died Sunday, May 16, 2010 St. Luke Roosevelt Hospital in Manhattan. Born in Albany, he was the son of Rosemary Stemm Day and the late Alexander Day. He had been president of American Steel and Aluminum Corp., Albany where he worked for over 40 years.
