Albany - David John Browne III, 58, died Thursday, May 9, 2019, at his sister's home in Rutland, Vermont.

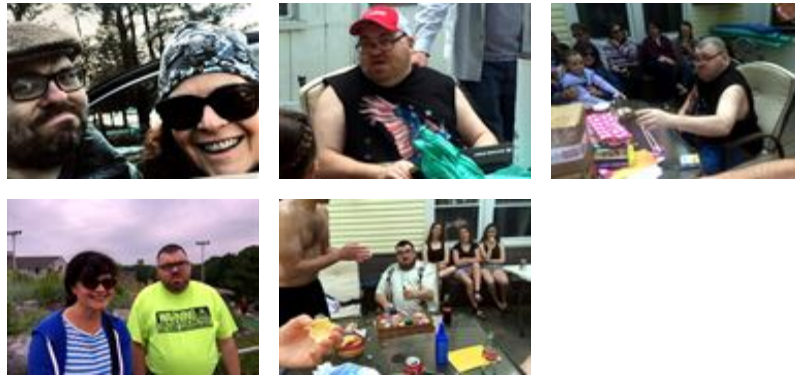
