Little River, SC-Dennis Paul O'Brien, 60, of Little River, SC died March 18 after an accidental fall in his home. He was born January 7, 1953 in Albany and was a 1971 graduate of Cardinal McCloskey High School and a 1973 graduate of Morrisville State College.

He was employed for more than 25 years by Camp Dresser & McKee (now CDM Smith) in Edison, New Jersey, most recently as manager of CDM's Operation and Maintenance Services Group. Prior to that, he worked for Clinton Bogart Associates of Fort Lee, NJ; the New York State Environmental Facilities Corporation; the New York Department of Environmental Conservation; and the Albany County Sewer District.
