Delmar-Dominic Gregory Gilbert passed away peacefully on Wednesday, November 25, 2020 after a long illness. He was born March 12, 1934 at his home, Carpenters, in Shipley, Sussex, England to Roland and Kathleen (Reynolds) Gilbert.

One of 11 children, he immigrated to the United States and in his business career rose to the level of Group SVP – Special Operations -Bank of New York. Upon retirement, he started and operated a management- consulting business. His greatest achievement was the family he loved so very much, and all of his extended family and friends. Because of heart failure in 2010, he had a Left Ventricle Assist Device (LVAD) implanted. Over the next 10 years he would counsel countless LVAD candidates and their families. 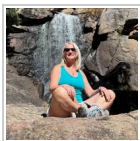
