Albany, NY-Edith E. "Edie" Trager, in her 100th year, entered Eternal Life Saturday, February 11, 2023 in the Hospice Inn at St. Peter's Hospital surrounded by her loving family.

Born in Rensselaer March 20, 1923, Edie was the daughter of the late Edward and Eleanor Carlson Gardner. In 1944, during World War II, Edith met the love of her life, Cy Trager, at a USO dance and they married in 1946.
