Albany, NY – Eleanor M. Ryan, 84, of Albany, died peacefully at Albany Medical Center on Thursday, May 9, 2024, surrounded by her family.

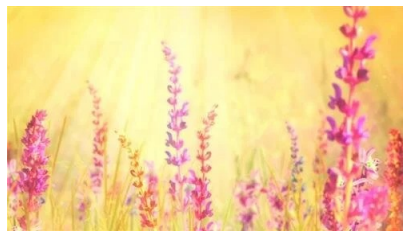

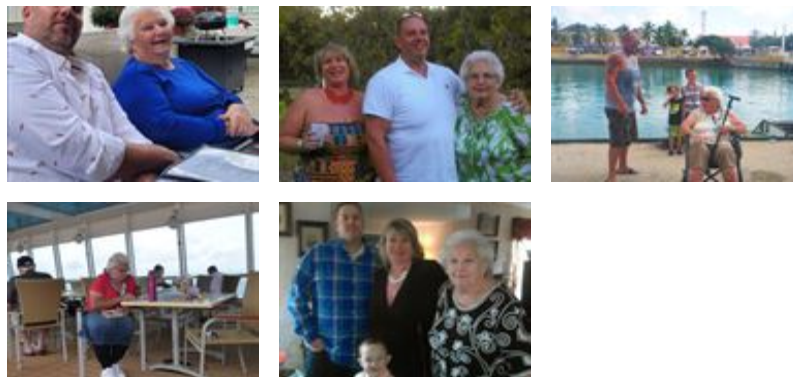
