Albany - Elizabeth (Betty) F. Momrow entered eternal life Wednesday, February 10, at Kingsway Nursing Home.

Born in Albany, she was the daughter of the late Russell & Margaret (Houghkirk) Herchenroder. A lifetime resident of Colonie, she was employed for 37 years with the A&P Tea Company as a statistician. After retiring from the A&P, she worked in the Albany County Comptrollers office and retired as Director of Internal Control at the age of 85.

Betty was a member of the Colonie Democratic Committee since 1952 and served as Chairwoman for 10 years. She was also Secretary, Vice Chairwoman & Treasurer for the Albany County Democratic Committee. She was also member of the State & National Democratic Committees. In 2000 she was a Lector at the Electoral College.

Betty was the wife of the late Henry Myers, Jr. and Charles Momrow. Sister of the late James Herchenroder (Jean), Earl Herchenroder (Roseann) & Russell Herchenroder Jr. (Shirley).
