



## F. Donald Lewis

June 9, 1916 - December 29, 2012

Palm Beach Gardens, FL- F. Donald (Don) Lewis passed away in Palm Beach Gardens, FL, on December 29, 2012. Born on June 9, 1916, in Hartford, CT, to Nettie and Freeman Clark Lewis, he was 96 1/2 years old.

Don was a long-time resident of Loudonville, NY, outside of Albany. For over 50 years, he represented the Prudential Insurance Company in both sales and agency management. For several years, he was one of the top ten producers among Prudential's over 10,000 agents.

Don was also an extremely active and optimistic leader and organizer in more than two dozen business, civic, not-for-profit, and philanthropic organizations. He served on the boards of directors of seven of them and was chair or president of the Albany Lions Club, the local chapter of the American Heart Association, and the Albany Executives Association, the latter of which he helped to found. In addition, Don was a Mason, a Shriner, an elder of the First Presbyterian Church of Albany, and a member of the First Presbyterian Church of North Palm Beach.

Don was married for over forty years to Edna Hutchinson Lewis, who died in 1980, and is survived by his wife of over 30 years, Nancy Edmonds Lewis. He is also survived by his three children: Donald Hutchinson Lewis of Valparaiso, IN; Charles Ashby Lewis of Evanston, IL; and Mary Elizabeth Husman of Port St. Lucie, FL, and Nancy's children: Susan Katherine Sherman of Phoenix,

AZ, and Scott McLean Sherman of Peoria, AZ. He had ten grandchildren and twenty-five great-grandchildren, who knew him as “Bompa”.

A memorial service was held at the First Presbyterian Church of North Palm Beach on January 2, 2013. In lieu of flowers, donations may be made to the Church (717 Prosperity Farms Road, North Palm Beach 33408).

Don’s remains will be interred in Albany Rural Cemetery at a later date.
