Albany-Felicia G. (Parzych) Menneto, 90, passed away unexpectedly on Wednesday, September 2nd, 2015 with family by her side.

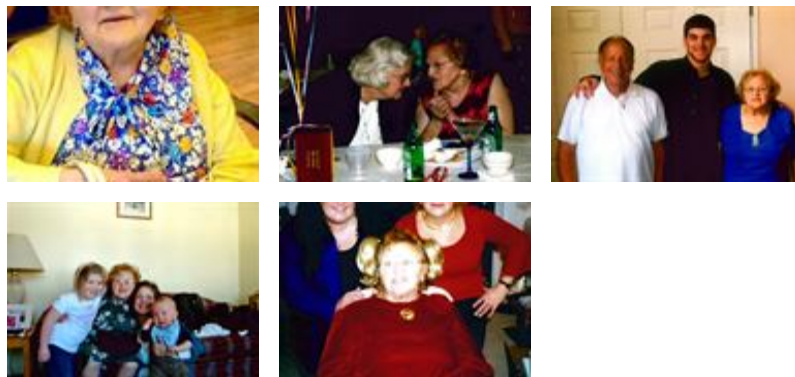
