Menands-Francis P. Mulderry, 88, died Saturday, December 26, 2020 at St. Peter's Hospital. Francis was born to Francis J. and Marjorie Mulderry on May 21, 1932. Frank was married to his college sweetheart, Evelyn Crowley Mulderry for 65 years and together they raised eight children

.Frank graduated from CBA in 1950. He went on to The College of the Holy Cross graduating in 1954. Graduating from Albany Law School in 1958 Frank became a member of the Albany Bar Association and practiced law until his retirement in 2018.

Frank was a member of the CBA Century Club and of The College of the Holy Cross Alumni Club of Eastern NY.

Frank was a lifetime member and past president of the Classic Car Club of America. He enjoyed caravans around the United States in his classic cars, with his wife by his side. His favorite car was his 1931 Model A Roadster which he purchased in 1948. He was also proud of "Irish Mist", his 1932 Hacker Craft that was a big part of family summers in Lake George.

He was a lifetime member of Wolferts Roost country Club and a former member of the Albany Curling Club. Frank was a member and past president of the New York Senior's golf Association as well as a member of the Venice Lakes Golf Club in Venice, FL.

Frank was a communicant of St. Joan of Arc Church and past president of its pastoral council.

Frank is survived by his wife and his children: Eileen, Broadalbin, Erin, Vieques, PR, James, Menands, Maureen (Robert Hoffer), MA Brian, Menands, Catherine Mattice (Ronald), Menands, Margaret (Randy Howard), Leesburg, VA and Patricia Stewart (Robert), Melrose, MA. Frank is also survived by his sister Anne Hans of Venice, FL and his eighteen grandchildren and seven great grandchildren.
