February 24, 1959 - March 23, 2024

Ballston Lake, NY - Frank J. Cimmino, 65, died Saturday, March 23, 2024, peacefully at his home with his family after a heroic battle with glioblastoma.

Born in Brooklyn, he was the son of the late Frank and Emanuela Cimmino. Frank graduated from Aviation High School in 1977. With dreams of becoming a pilot, he set off for Syracuse University, but returned home because he missed his one true love far too much: a real Brooklyn girl from around the corner, Laura. His dream evolved into becoming a loving husband, having married Laura in 1983, raising two sons, and rising through the ranks as a New York City Police Officer, eventually achieving Sergeant. He was a First Responder on the scene at 9/11 and retired from the police force soon after. He then performed security installations and eventually worked at the 9/11 Museum as a security officer supervisor before retiring to spend time with his grandson, Franklin.

Frank will be remembered for his love of Oreos, Entenmann's donuts, marshmallows, midnight jelly sandwiches, and frosting straight out of the tin. He was a seasoned bargain hunter, surfing in the deepest corners of the internet looking for the best deals. His big, loud personality and love for laughs made you feel at home when he was in your company. Frank adored all things that moved - from airplanes and Mustangs to tanks and motorcycles. Being an ultimate Mr. Fix-It and junk connoisseur, with his 20-year old materials, he

could fix and build anything he set his mind to. His fanny pack and multiple pockets seemingly had exactly what you needed right when you needed it! Our neighbor Steve could never understand why Frank always had to improve on brand new cars, motorcycles, and bicycles. He would ask, "Isn't that brand new?" But Frank loved his collections: tools, bourbon, camping gear, tools, motorcycle jackets, tools, and more tools.

Through it all, those who knew Frank loved him for his generosity, love of life, and uniqueness. He always chose to take the scenic route through life, and wouldn't dare ask for directions.
