



Frederick Lonergan

April 30, 1927 - January 15, 2010

Albany-Frederick Lonergan, 82, died Friday, January 15, 2010 at St. Peter's Hospital. Born in Green Island, he was the son of the late Ted and Irene Mitchell Lonergan.

Mr. Lonergan was a graduate of Christian Brothers High School. He served in the US Navy during World War II. After receiving a Bachelors Degree in accounting, he entered the FBI as a Special Agent in 1947 and served in the Little Rock, New York City and Albany field divisions prior to retiring in 1977 as a Supervisory Special Agent.

After retirement, Fred was employed by the State of New York, Deputy Attorney General for Medicaid Fraud Control as an investigator retiring in 1989. Fred continued to work as a private investigator primarily as a contractor for several government agencies. He was an avid golfer and fly fisherman. He was predeceased by his wife, Mona Lonergan.

He was the father of Mary Beth Lonergan, Frederick "Jeffrey" Lonergan and his wife Pam, Michael Lonergan and his wife Marybeth; grandfather of Jennifer Lonergan, Meghan Lonergan, and Brian Lonergan and his wife Sharon; brother of Phyllis Gottung and her husband William and the late John Lonergan; many nieces and nephews also survive.
