Fritz was born in war torn Yugoslavia. At the age of two his family was forced to flee his hometown and move to Germany where he spent his early years growing up in a refugee camp. When Fritz was 14 years old, his family made the brave decision to leave the life they knew and loved to immigrate to the United States, in hope of a safer and more productive future for their family and generations to come. From farming in Nebraska, to learning English while in high school in Brooklyn, his family traveled throughout the US until they ultimately fulfilled their “American Dream” of settling and working the picturesque farm they discovered in Roxbury, NY.

Fritz’s next adventure was Culinary School after which he spent fond years working together with his twin brother, Philipp, at the Lake Mohonk Resort. He then went on to study electronics at HVCC and ultimately completed his bachelor’s degree at Arizona State University. Eventually, Fritz returned home

to be near his family and settled in Albany, NY where he tirelessly worked for over 30 years at the NY Telephone Company.

In Albany, Fritz began the second chapter of his life when he met his beloved wife, Donna.
