Victory Mills- George F. Garney, 65, passed away Saturday, February 14, 2015 surrounded by his family. Born July 2, 1949 in Schenectady, he was the son of Francis (Sonny) and the late Grace Fifield Garney. After graduating from Schalmont High School, he proudly served his country in the United States Air Force from 1967-1971.
