Albany-Harold T. Joyce, 78, formerly of Academy Road, entered Eternal Life Wednesday, September 21, 2016 at Good Samaritan Lutheran Home in Delmar where he resided for the past 3 years. Born in Albany, he was the son of the late Harold and Mary Heery Joyce.

Harold was a 1955 graduate of Christian Brothers Academy, Albany. He worked at the Port of Albany for 40 years. Harold was a member of the former St. Theresa of Avila parish in Albany, where he also served as a choir member, Parish Council member, Prayer and Worship Committee member and Finance Committee Chairman. He also served as a Eucharist Minister, and Lay Minister to the Homebound. Harold has been a communicant of the Parish of Mater Christi since the closing of St. Theresa's. Harold was a member of the Diocesan Eucharistic Adoration Committee. Harold was a longtime member of the Third Order of St. Dominic.

Harold loved classical music and was a season ticket holder for both Tanglewood and SPAC. His love of music was not just as a spectator. He was active in many choirs, and attended Bethlehem Reformed Church, Selkirk, NY where he also sang in their choir. He was a caregiver for his mother, Mary, and was always available to provide transportation for the Sisters of Mercy.

He was the brother of Lawrence H. Joyce (Rose Marie) and the late Sr.

Maureen Joyce, RSM; uncle of Daniel Joyce (MaryBeth), Maureen Tisiere, Marybeth Maurice (David); grand uncle of Daniel and Sean Tisiere and Emily Myles and Owen Joyce; survived by his longtime friend and caregiver, Raymond Hohl of Selkirk, NY.
