Albany-Hazel Dexheimer VanAernam, 88, died Sunday, April 5, 2015 at her home in Albany. She was born in Ghent, NY on October 21, 1925, the daughter of the late Frederick and Pearl Dexheimer.

Hazel was raised in Ghent and graduated from Philmont High School. She and her late husband, Richard VanAernam, owned and operated the Ten Eyck Record Shop in Albany for several years.
