Albany, NY-James Richard McCarthy, 86, entered Eternal Life Thursday, January 1, 2026 at Albany Medical Center Hospital.

Richard graduated from Vincentian Institute Class of 1958, and then met the love of his life while working in the Trust Department at National Commercial Bank. He retired in 1998 from the New York State Thruway after 38 years. After three years of retirement he then went to work for Quester III in 2001, after 20 years he once again retired in 2021.

J. Richard was the son of the late Charles F. McCarthy Sr and Charlotte Harris McCarthy.
