Albany-James C. Mangan, 74, died Friday, April 25, 2014 at St. Peter's Hospital surrounded by his loving family. Born in Westminster, England he was the son of the late Michael and Bridget Nash Mangan. Jim came to America in 1959 at the age of 19.

Jim sang and played guitar with the Galway Blazers, along with many other bands in England and America. He was a member of the Comhaltas Ceoltoiri Eireann Irish Music Hall of Fame.

He was a steamfitter and 51 year member of Plumbers and Steamfitters Local Union #7, Albany.
