Albany- James Thomas McManus, 89, of Albany, died Sunday July 22, 2012 at St. Peter's Nursing and Rehabilitation Center.

James was the son of the late John and Mary Tobin McManus. He attended Vincentian Institute and Siena College. He enlisted in the Navy in November of 1942 and spent forty months patrolling the Atlantic and Pacific Theatres. Upon returning from service, he set up an independent insurance agency with Joseph Tessitore. He later was associated with Thomas Golden at the Golden-McManus Insurance Agency.

He is survived by his beloved wife Beatrice Tully; his children, Ellen (Gerard) Laurencin of Toulouse, France, Mary of Albany, James Jr. of NYC and Bridget (Lawrence) Honeycutt of Templeton, CA; his grandchildren, Sara, Danielle, Madeleine, Gabrielle, Ellen, Heidi, Julie, Daniel and Philip; and his great-grandchildren, Timothee, Lilly and Eleanor.
