Janet retired at the age of 85 after 40 years of devoted service. She valued her time at Teresian House and loved working with the elderly. Janet was a member of the Board of Directors of St. Patrick's School, Troy; founding board member of Ladies of Charity of Albany, Board Member of the Carmelite Sister for the Aged and Infirm, and a founding board member of Teresian House Foundation.

Janet enjoyed summers at Lake George, skiing at Gore Mtn, and lounging by the pool. But most of all Janet cherished spending time with her children and grandchildren. She was a lover of life.
