Albany-John J. Camadine, Jr. entered into eternal life on April 2nd, 2018 at the age of 93 after a long illness. He was born on November 23rd, 1924 in Albany, NY to the late John J. Camadine, Sr. and the late Linda Stroebele Camadine.

He was predeceased by his brother Michael Camadine. John was married to his beloved wife, the late Lillian M. (Atchinson) Camadine for over fifty years. A lifelong Albany resident, he graduated from Blessed Sacrament School, Vincentian Institute, and attended Siena College. After the war, he was employed at Hudson Valley Appliances, Ramapo Wine & Liquor Co., and for many years as an auditor at the Albany County Comptroller's Office proudly working until the age of 90.

Most importantly, John was a devoted husband and father. As an avid sports fan, John loved rooting for his favorite teams, the NY Giants and the NY Mets. He also loved boating and fishing with his family on the Mohawk and Hudson Rivers
