Albany, New York - John H. Nardacci, 95, passed away peacefully on Friday, June 14, 2024, at Teresian House in Albany, N.Y. Born on February 6, 1929, he was a lifelong resident of Albany and the son of the late Lillian Corsetti Nardacci Mirabello and Charles Nardacci.

John graduated from Philip Schuyler High School, where he excelled in athletics and was selected to the All-Albany Football Team for three consecutive seasons. He was predeceased by his beloved wife of 51 years, Josephine L. (Santiago) Nardacci, in 2005, and his daughter, Deborah Nardacci Sottosanti (Gary Sottosanti), in 2020.

He was also preceded in death by his sisters, Theresa Traynor and Geraldine V. Romeo, and his brother, Donald C. Nardacci. John was a proud Army veteran of the Korean War. He worked for the International Union of Operating Engineers Local 106 for 35 years, retiring in 1982. Later, he worked as a custodian for the Albany School District for 10 years, retiring in 1992.
