



## John Gerard Norton "Jack"

February 4, 1943 - June 20, 2024

Loudonville, NY-John Gerard Norton ("Jack") of Loudonville passed away on Thursday, June 20, 2024 at the age of 81.

Jack was born in February of 1943 in West Albany, NY to John J. "Skip" and Florence (Kross) Norton. He attended and graduated from Colonie High School and served in the National Guard for several years. After the early and unexpected loss of his father, he helped his mother with several responsibilities including raising his three younger brothers.

A man determined to figure out things himself, Jack learned and became passionate about the art of carpentry. He first started working with his mother in her home building business. Jack and his brother, James (Jim) founded Norton Home Builders in 1969. For over 40 years, they built houses "right, from the ground up" that have served as treasured homes to hundreds of families in the greater Loudonville community.

As a father, Jack was determined to provide a safe and supportive environment for his family. He spent countless hours driving to and standing on the sides of athletic fields, ski mountains and in recital halls supporting the endeavors of his children and their friends. He particularly enjoyed spending time with his son deer hunting in the woods and was an avid fan of auto racing, tennis and classic movies.

Retirement should have been more enjoyable for Jack, a man that worked hard and tirelessly his entire life. Unfortunately, he battled several challenges with his health, most recently Parkinsonism for the last several years.

Predeceased by his parents, Jack is survived by his loving and caring wife of 48 years, Carol (Zacharewicz) Norton, his two children, John (Beatty Schlueter) and Kristin (Matthew MacDonald), as well as five grandchildren, of whom he was very proud; Claire, Reuk, Sean, Biggs, and Isla. He is also survived by his three brothers: James, Robert (Barbara) and Thomas (Kathy), a sister-in-law, Alice Zacharewicz, and brothers-in-law Stanley (Linda) Zacharewicz and John (Nan) Puchalski, as well as several nieces, nephews and cousins.
