Manchester Center, VT- John V. Ringwood 71 passed away peacefully after a brief illness on Saturday April 4, 2015 at St Peter's Hospital surrounded by his loving family. Born in Albany, NY he was one of five children of the late Nelson and Agnes (Horan) Ringwood. He was a graduate of Blessed Sacrament Grade School, Vincentian High School, and Siena College and later served in the United States Army.

John was an active member of Christ Our Savior Church in Manchester, Vermont, member of the Manchester Vermont Planning Board, member of The Green Mountain Fly Fishing Club, and also a member of The Vincentian High School Hall of Fame.
