Albany-It is with great sadness, that we announce the passing of our beloved father Joe, on December 12, 2020. He passed peacefully in his home with his loving family surrounding him. 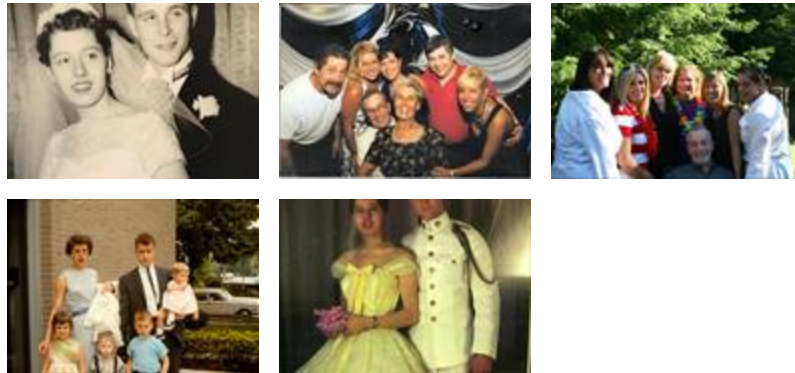
