Albany, NY-Joseph Mazzoccone, 96, entered Eternal Life Monday, February 6, 2023. Born in Treglio, Italy he was the son of Giovanni and Giacinta DiDonato Mazzoccone.

Joseph worked on his family farm in Italy, growing grapes, olives and figs. He served in the Italian Carabinieri for four years. He immigrated to Canada with most of his family, where he met Mary Fiorella who was visiting from New York. Joseph and Mary married in Toronto in 1952. They returned to Albany where they raised their family. Joseph worked at Albany Felt, Schaefer Brewery and the Albany City School District. He retired to enjoy his family, making wine, tending his garden, and playing Bocce, and Scopa.

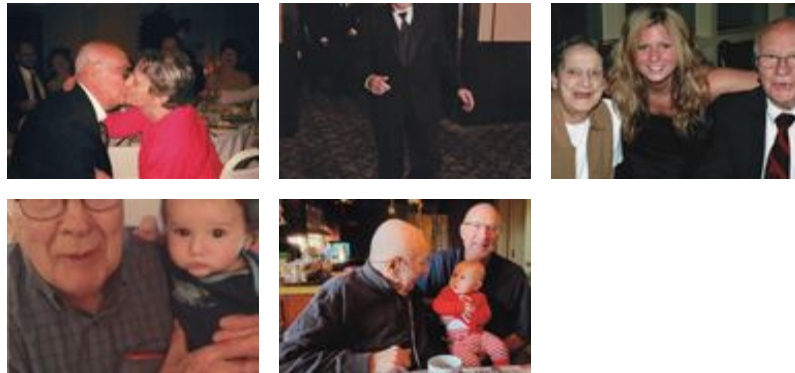
