Albany-Joseph A. Gaudet, 86, died Wednesday, October 14, 2009 at Teresian House. Born in Chicago, IL, son of the late Joseph and Cleonica Connell Gaudet. Joe was a US Navy WW II veteran, serving in the Pacific Theater.
