



## Kate Birdsall

January 23, 1923 - March 15, 2010

Albany-Kate Birdsall, 87, known as ‘the Angel of Rosemont Street,’ died Monday, March 15, 2010 in the Hospice Inn at St. Peter’s Hospital. Born in West Conesville, she was the daughter of the late Clinton and Kate Craig Birdsall.

Kate was a graduate of the first graduating class of the Delaware Academy and Vasser Bros. School of Nursing.
