Albany-Katherine A. "Kitty" Davey, 85, died Wednesday, October 13, 2010 at Samaritan Hospital in Troy, NY after a brief illness. Born in Hyannis, MA to Marshall and Ruth Spofford Pulsifer. Katherine was predeceased by her brother, Marshall Darling Pulsifer and her sister Myrtle Ruth Pulsifer Hill.

Kitty was a graduate of the first Cadet Corps of Nurses, Russell Sage College, Troy, NY. She was destined for overseas duty when WW II ended. She worked at Albany Medical Center Hospital, stopping briefly to raise a family. She retired from Albany Medical Center in 1986 at the age of 62. In addition to being a devoted wife and mother, Kitty found time to become a Brownie and Girls Scout Troop Leader and PTO President at West Albany Elementary School. She was an avid bowler and belonged to the senior leagues for many years. She especially enjoyed camping at Schroon River Campsites and had a permanent site there for over 30 years. She attended Siena Basketball games with her husband until his death in 2009. She was an excellent seamstress, cook and enjoyed entertaining for her family and extended family. Her children were the special joys of her life, as well as her grandchildren and great grandchildren. She will be dearly missed.
