Albany-Kathy Bentley Rosch passed away peacefully at St. Peters Hospital in Albany on August 29th, 2021 at the age of 64. 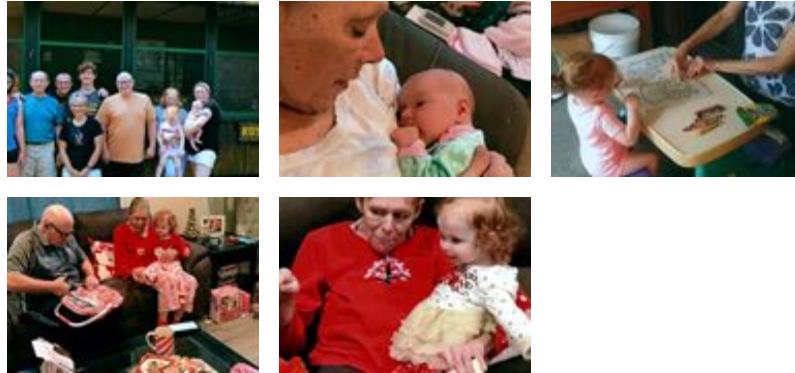
