Delmar- Kevin T. McCann died peacefully surrounded by his loving family on July 31, 2017 at the Hospice Inn in St. Peter's Hospital in Albany. Kevin was born February 18, 1950 in Albany to the late Paul and Bettie McCann. He was a 1968 graduate of Vincentian Institute in Albany.

Kevin worked for many years as a contractor and landscaper in the Capital District Area and was also a well-known area antiques collector and dealer. He was an accomplished artist and guitarist and appeared at Café Lena in Saratoga Springs, The Fox Hollow Festival in Petersburg, New York, The Eighth Step Coffee House in Albany, and other local venues. In recent years he enjoyed fishing at Burden Lake in Averill Park and especially September striped bass fishing in Cape Cod.
