



Kyran Joseph "Ky" Flannery Jr

August 29, 1944 - July 7, 2010

Delmar-Kyran Joseph "Ky" Flannery Jr., 65, died peacefully at St. Peter's Hospice Inn on July 7, 2010. He was the beloved son of the late Kyran Joseph Flannery Sr. and Mary Ellen Walsh Flannery.

A lifelong resident of Albany, Ky was a graduate of St. Catherine of Siena Grammar School, Christian Brothers Academy, College of the Holy Cross and Albany Law School.

Ky spent his entire career in private practice with D'Agostino, Hoblock, Flannery & Jeram. He was active in the Mater Christi parish (formerly St. Catherine of Siena) and served as President of both the School Board and the Parish Council.

Ky was an avid golfer who achieved 3 holes in one and especially enjoyed rounds at both Pebble Beach and Old Head in Kinsale, Ireland. He was a sports enthusiast and dog lover.

Ky is survived by his wife Judy White Flannery and his daughters Susan Flannery Huffman (Minor), Kristin Flannery Barnes (Michael) and Erin Flannery Pizzo (Michael) and his grandchildren Emily Huffman, Taylor, Justin and Kieran Barnes, Aidan and Kyra Pizzo and step grandson Raymond Huffman.

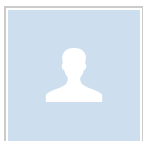

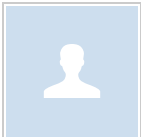
