Albany, NY – Lawrence Michael Cuzdey, 89, passed away peacefully surrounded by family on Tuesday, November 19, 2024, at Northside Forsyth Hospital in Cumming, GA.

Lawrence (Larry) was born on October 30, 1935, in Albany and graduated from Roessleville High School in Colonie in 1953.

He was predeceased by his parents, Michael J. and Helen (Wood) Cuzdey; and the love of his life, wife Rosemary (Bolognino) Cuzdey.

Larry and Rosemary were married on April 24, 1960, and enjoyed 62 years together. They were blessed with many friends across multiple states and enjoyed a large extended family.

Larry served in the United States Army from 1953 – 1958. He was a skilled dental technician in the tri-city area, and he learned his trade from working with his father at a young age. Larry owned his own dental laboratory and retired from the VA Stratton Hospital dental laboratory where he served his fellow veterans for over 20 years.

We are thankful we had Uncle Larry in our lives for so long, and grateful to the Cuzdey “kids” for sharing him with us. We will savor our memories forever.

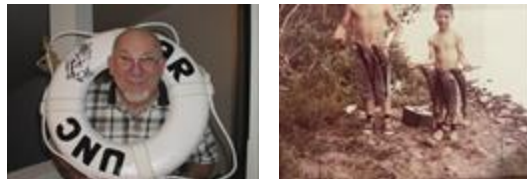
