



Lawrence R. Prichard

August 21, 1945 - November 22, 2024

Guilford, NY-Lawrence R. "Larry" Prichard, 79, entered Eternal Life Friday, November 22, 2024 at Albany Medical Center Hospital. Born in Schenectady, he was the son of Samuel and Hazel Sonne Prichard.

Larry was graduated from Notre Dame-Bishop Gibbons High School, Siena College, and Mount St. Mary's Seminary in Emmitsburg, MD.

Larry was ordained a Priest for the Roman Catholic Diocese of Albany on May 13, 1972. He served as Associate Pastor at Christ the King Church for ten years. His ministry there included Director of Religious Education, and founder of the Cellar for Teens. Larry went on to become the longtime supervisor of security and housekeeping at Crossgates Mall, and then Avila Retirement Community as a security guard. Larry was a member of the Knights of Columbus Council 3357.

He was the brother of the late Martha Prichard Martinelli; former brother-in-law of Philip Martinelli; longtime friend of Paul and Kathy Nolles, Anne Nowak, Joanne Haas, Darlene Robinson Cashin and Dimetri Perdaris; uncle of Jeffrey Martinelli (Dee), Tina Forchilli (Paul), Randy Martinelli (Gina), Coreen Prysmont (Michael), Gina Martinelli LaRoe, and Tonya Martinelli; several grandnieces and grandnephews survive.
