West Albany-Lena Lenora Luciano Scaringe passed away on Thursday, January 7, 2016 at home with her beloved husband by her side. She was born in Albany on January 6, 1931. She was the daughter of the late Vincent and Lucy Luciano and sister of the late Lenora Luciano.

She was a graduate of Philip Schuyler High School and upon graduating worked for New York State as a key punch operator. She worked for 16 years and left to have her first child, Paula, who was born on Mothers Day, after 11 years of marriage.

Lena had several different career paths. She worked at the Family Rosary for many years and later went on to be a fragrance representative at different locations including Macy's, Jordan Marsh and Filenes. Later on she returned to work for the Town of Colonie, and a few different State Agencies.

Lena was married to Tony for 61 years and they enjoyed a wonderful life together. She died one day after her 85th birthday and stayed alive long enough for her family to celebrate it with her. She loved casino gambling and she looked forward each year to the Saratoga meet. After Tony retired in 1988, they took over 20 cruises out of Fort Lauderdale, including a 20 day boat trip through Italy.
