



Leo T. Nolan

June 6, 1929 - September 11, 2010

Guilderland-Leo T. Nolan, 81, died Saturday, September 11, 2010 at Our Lady of Mercy Life Center surrounded by his loving wife and family. Born in Amsterdam, he was the son of the late Francis T. and Marguerite Dunn Nolan. Mr. Nolan was a US Navy Seabee, serving during the Korean War.

Leo was a longtime member of the Sheetmetal Union Local 83. He was the former owner of L & T Roofing. He was the former groundkeeper for the Guilderland Pinebush Girls Softball League. He also worked for 16 years as the Maintenance Supervisor for the Brookside Bluff Condo Association in Florida.

He was a charter member and former Exalted Ruler of the Guilderland Elks, #2480. Leo was also honored as "Elk of the Year." He was a 38 year associate member of the Westmere Fire Department, where he also served for 14 years as treasurer. Leo was a member of both the American Legion, and Loyal Order of Moose. Together with his dear wife Lois, they sponsored over 150 Foster children through Catholic Charities over a 35 year period.
