ALBANY- Lewis M. Dilwith, 95, passed away on March 7, 2015. He was born and lived most of his life in Albany. He enlisted in the U.S. Army and served from 1935 to 1945, retiring with the rank of Captain. While training at Ft. McClellan, Alabama, he met his future wife, Gertie Mae Marr. During World War II, he landed on Normandy Beach and fought in the Battle of the Bulge during which he was awarded the Silver Star for gallantry in action. His last employment was with the Abilene Pest Control Company. Lew was an avid golfer and always maintained his sense of humor.

Lew was predeceased by his loving wife, Gertie Mae. Infant daughter, Marsha; granddaughter Jessica Wolfman; sister, Mary Clow and brother, James.

He is survived by his children; Robert Dilwith and Pamela (Neil) Wolfman; grandfather of Gregory (Valerie) Bidwell, Jason Dilwith, Ben and Austin Wolfman; great grandfather of Madison Bidwell and Mason Dilwith. Also survived by his brother, Joseph Dilwith and sister, Teresa Dot.
