April 22, 1954 - April 2, 2015

Waterford-Lois G. Smith-Law, 60, died Thursday, April 2, 2015 in the Hospice Inn at St. Peter's Hospital. Born in Albany, Lois is the daughter of Charles J. Smith and the late Miriam Porter Smith.

Lois was a graduate of Shaker High School, Albany Business College, and currently attending Empire State College. She currently served as Director of Operations (SPHR) for Deily & Glastetter, LLP and she previously worked for Manpower, Metroplex and TAG.

Lois was the past chairwoman of the Schenectady Chamber of Commerce Foundation, Schenectady Chamber of Commerce Board of Directors, and the Schenectady County Community College Foundation Board. She was a founding member of the Tech Valley Chamber Coalition and past vice chair of the United Way of Schenectady. Lois was an active member of the Town of Halfmoon Planning Board.

She was the beloved and cherished wife of Christopher R. Law; dear sister of Susan Smith (Bob Gronczniak) and Charles Smith Jr; dear aunt of Nicole Smith, Sean Smith and Jessie Law; sister-in-law of Scott Law; she is survived by many dear friends and colleagues.

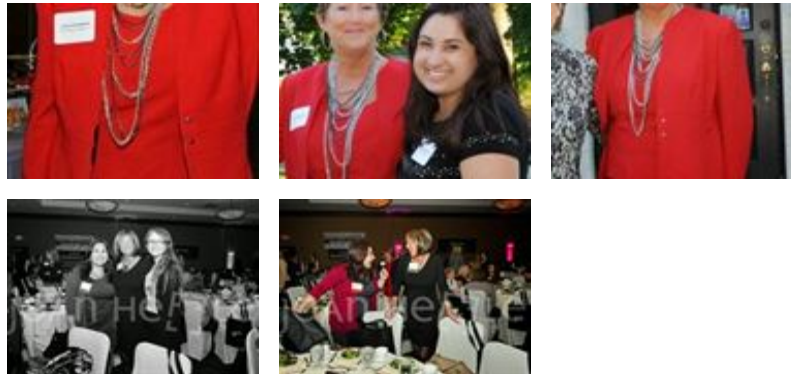
