Albany-Lois K. Wisnewski, 89, of Albany passed away on December 7, 2013 at St. Peter's Hospital. Born in Albany on January 28, 1924, Lois was a graduate of the Kenwood Academy and Manhattanville College. She served as a Red Cross Volunteer Nurses Aide during WWII at Knickerbocker Hospital in Harlem. Later, she worked for the Second Service Command and Veterans Administration in Albany before she became a reading and math teacher at Albany Public Schools, where she touched many lives. Lois also devoted time after her retirement to volunteering at St. Teresa of Avila school.

Lois took her first flight in 1983 and shortly afterward became a world traveler. She visited Europe, Asia, South America, and the Caribbean and was always up for an adventure. She also loved spending time with her family at Ogunquit Beach in Maine. Lois had a great sense of humor, was a good sport, and always laughed along with her (sometimes mischievous) family. You couldn't get anything past her!
