Lucy Rodriguez, 73, passed away peacefully, on Monday, October 26th, 2020.

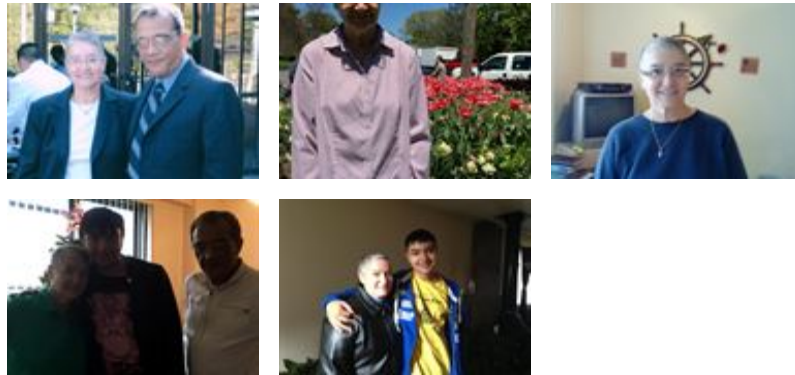
