BALLSTON SPA- On Monday, January 17, 2011 God has brought home to Himself Margaret V. Tynan who now rejoices in heaven with Him. Born in Albany on Sept. 11, 1921, she was the daughter of the late William and Bertha Susser. Marge was the mother of Barry E. (Mary), Bryan W. (Sandy), Carol J. Mann (Ron) and Lori Jean Tynan. She is survived by 11 grandchildren, 22 great grandchildren and 3 great great grandchildren. She was pre-deceased by her brother William “Bud” Susser.

Founder of Tynan Center for Dance in 1972, Marge started her dance career under the tutelage of Tommy Sternfeld, who produced a local, long-running talent show called the Teenage Barn. Tynan’s style was clear and distinct. She referred to herself as an “Old Time Hooper” with a respect and admiration for Eleanor Powell. Marge had a long standing commitment with the Center for Disability Services Telethon, as well as many other community organizations. Marge’s legacy will live on through countless students and many generations in the Capital District dance community.
