Albany-Marie Hoyt passed away peacefully in the Hospice Inn, St. Peter's Hospital after a bout with cancer on Wednesday, September 7, 2016.

Born on December 5, 1948 in Ridley Park, PA, she graduated from the School of the Holy Child in Sharon Hill, PA, Oberlin College Conservatory of Music, and Loyola School of Law. She taught elementary school music in inner city Philadelphia and later kindergarten and first grade in Bellevue, MI, St. Stephen's in New Orleans, and three inner city New Orleans public schools. She was an active volunteer at St. Francis Chapel, serving as pilgrimage secretary and as their head of eucharistic ministers and lectors.

She is survived by Reed, her loving husband of 44 years, two brothers: Edward Witomski of Newark, Delaware and Stanley Witomski of Media, PA, and a sister, Felicia Sinnett of Alexandria, VA, as well as her first cousin, Vicki Flood of Devon, PA, her uncle, Dr. Thomas Witomski of Manasquan, NJ, and cousins Arthur and Mark Lopatka, and Mara McDermott in the Chicago area.
