December 6, 1918 - January 31, 2013

Clifton Park-Marie Louise Carroll Cronin, 94, died Thursday, January 31, 2013 in Clifton Park. Born in New York City, she was the daughter of the late Richard and Marie Louise Collins Elliffe.

Carroll graduated from the Academy of Mount Saint Ursula and the College of Mount Saint Vincent. She taught in the New York City School system and went on to work in the Department of Chemical Warfare during WW II. After the war she worked in the advertising industry in New York City and retired as a manager for Ciba-Geigy Pharmaceuticals in Ardsley, NY.
